Parents' special needs/physical challenges make this a unique family situation. Our son is a typical, energetic, lovable 4 year-old boy. We need a team player who respects our parenting style — who is simply 'extra hands and feet'; helping us be the best parents we can possibly be. We are capable, competent adults who happen to have physical challenges. We look at our helpers as an extension of our family — not simply 'employees'.



Explain your philosophy about child discipline? Reinforcement of positive behavior is essential. Nanny supports, but does not take over, parent discipline strategies. TimeOut/Thinking Chair has been used. Preferred toys/activities have been taken away for short periods. Spanking is only occasional—when safety is in question due to the behavior—and is solely the parents' call and responsibility.

Have you had a nanny before? If yes, what has been your experience? Yes. Overall, positive experience, given a clear understanding of our needs. We have had the same primary nanny for almost 3 years, who will continue in her current position. We now need extra help with a baby on the way. Previous nanny was with us slightly less than 2 years and left for family reasons. We encourage clear communication and teamwork.
